

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The compact and lightweight Combat Thermal Mount™ brings the thermal to an absolute co-witness height of a 1.54° optical centerline from the rail. With two models, the CTM™ can be employed for either the Trijicon® SkeetIR™x or the Pixels on Target™ VooDoo-S™ (models not interchangeable). Using a force-to-overcome mechanism, the thermal flips-to-side. The model for the VooDoo-S™ can be mounted for both right- and left-handed flip-to-side options.





If using the CTMTM for Trijicon® SkeetIRTMx, start at step 1. If using the CTMTM for Pixels on TargetTM VooDoo-STM, jump to step 2.

Up-end and seat thermal in FAST™ mount arm. Insert the existing mounting screws from your Trijicon® SkeetIR™x. Secure screws using a T8 bit driver. Lightly snug all screws before applying final torque to any.

Torque to manufacturer specifications. Jump to step 3.


Up-end and seat thermal in FASTTM mount arm. Insert the included four Thermal Mounting Screws. Secure screws using a 3/32 bit driver. Lightly snug all screws before applying final torque to any. **Torque to manufacturer specifications.** The model for the VooDoo-STM can be mounted for both right- and left-handed flip-to-side options.



Using a force-to-overcome mechanism, the thermal flips-to-side. Grasp the thermal body and pivot assembly down to the stowed position. Repeat in reverse to bring the thermal back into the active position.



Do not disassemble the mount. Doing so will void the warranty.
